





Victim & Perpetrator Age Comparision






Cause of Death

WE COUNT

Femicide rates continue to remain high in Ontario, as an additional 6 femicides have been reported in the month of August. A total of 34 femicides have been confirmed in Ontario since November 26th, 2021 and several other cases continue to be monitored pending further police investigation and charges. As previously highlighted within OAITH's femicide work, there is a need to focus on prevention initiatives, such as curriculum-based prevention in our schools and investing in communitybased responses for survivors, their children and those who cause harm to prevent severe violence and femicide. It is also essential however, that collaborative efforts among various levels of government and services are taken to address the social conditions that increase the risk of violence and the root causes of violence. To accomplish this, implementing the 86 recommendations from the Culleton, Kuzyk & Warmerdam Inquest can act as our compass towards safer communities. Community members can also support prevention initiatives in their local communities through the Neighbours, Friends and Family Campaign. This campaign aims to increase awareness regarding the signs of gender-based violence and how you can support loved ones who may be experiencing or perpetrating violence.
