A REFERRAL IS NOT NEEDED TO ACCESS ABORTION IN CANADA

- Plan B, an emergency contraceptive, is available over-the-counter at most pharmacies.

- Action Canada (Planned Parenthood Canada): for information about sexual and reproductive health, and referrals to clinics/hospitals that provide reproductive health services, including abortion, anywhere in Canada, call 1-888-642-2725 (9:00-9:00 EST) for immediate and confidential help.
- <u>Abortion Rights Coalition of Canada (ARCC)</u>: <u>Abortion Clinics and Services</u>, hotlines, funds, supports
 in Canada, and <u>Information for pregnant Queer and Trans people</u>.
- <u>Centr'Elles</u> offers free and confidential individual and group counselling services as well as accompaniment and referrals to other services, including abortion services, for French-speaking women aged 16 and up: (807) 476-5144 or 1-888-415-4156
- <u>Choice Connect</u> is a free and anonymous abortion referral web app that helps locate the nearest abortion provider. The app features detailed referral information for 120+ abortion providers and clinics across Canada.
- National Abortion Federation Canada (NAF Canada) provides assistance for patients with financial barriers to abortion care through the Dr. Henry Morgentaler Patient Assistance Fund.
 - NAF Hotline provides free, accurate information, confidential consultation/referrals to providers of quality abortion care, case management services and limited financial assistance to help cover cost of care and travel: 1-800-772-9100 (various hours).
- NorWest Community Health Centre has a midwifery program that offers 2SLGBTQI+ care, sexual
 health planning, reproductive healthcare, contraceptive counselling and placement of LARCs, such as
 IUDs and Nexplanon, pregnancy termination counselling, medication abortions until 9 weeks in
 collaboration with some of the other providers, and specialist referral services. Self-refer by calling:

- <u>Shore Centre</u> (Kitchener, ON) provides medication abortions via telemedicine for up to 9 weeks, as well as emotional support before and after an abortion.
- Thunder Bay District Health Unit (TBDHU) provides sexual health services. Call first thing in the morning on Tuesdays/Thursdays to access urgent appointments with a physician for assessment/referral for abortion care: (807) 625-5976 or 1-888-294-6630
- <u>Umbrella Medical Clinic</u> provides sexual health services, including birth control, emergency contraception, pregnancy testing, and abortion: (807) 698-7200
