


Quick Facts


- In 2021-2022, OAITH tracked a total of 52 femicides within media reports

Cause of Death




Victim Race

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



As can be seen within the December femicide report, gender-based violence (GBV), and femicide more specifically continue to be perpetrated by multiple relationship types, including intimate partners, family members and other known relationships as well as by men with unknown relationships who have targeted the victim due to their gender. Previous research has documented the link between previous gendered violence as a risk factor for lethal escalation of violence. This risk is not specific to only intimate partners of the offender but can also be seen more broadly. The link between previous histories of violence and men who perpetrate mass killings has been long documented (Geller et. al., 2021) and can also be seen in the recent mass killing that took place in Nova Scotia in 2020 (Tutton & McDonald, 2022). Two of the victims included within the December femicide report were killed in a mass-killing, by a man known to them, who also had a history of violence towards women (Omstead & Casey, 2022). The interconnection between those who perpetrate gendered violence and the risk for future lethal violence, poses a wide threat to communities and must be considered within prevention and intervention policy as it relates to offender treatment initiatives that work to address and prevent future violence from occurring.
